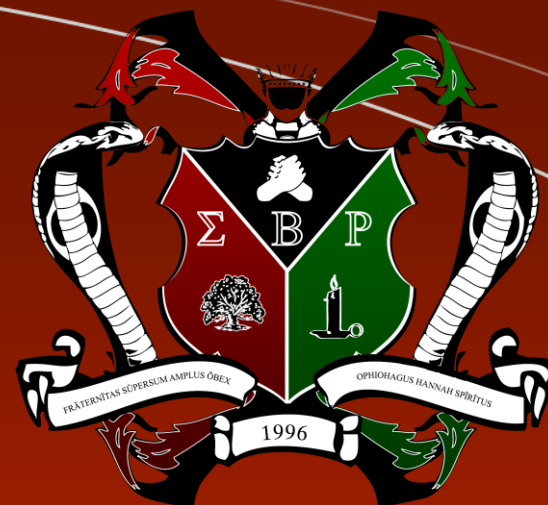

Modern day Sigma Beta Rho has grown considerably since its inception. It has expanded from its roots in the East Coast with 40 recognized chapters and colonies that span the breadth of the nation.

Through the efforts of our brothers and the reputation that precedes them, we have become the largest and most expansive fraternity of our kind in less than 15 years. As every day passes, we realize that we are another day closer to the nationwide network envisioned by our Founding Fathers.

The pillars of Sigma Beta Rho are our ideals of duty to **Society**, honoring the bond of **Brotherhood**, and **Remembrance** of our culture and that of our brothers. Our pillars were established upon the formation of the Alpha Chapter at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia, on August 16, 1996. Our founders realized the unique promise of a Greek-lettered organization that instills positive values amongst its members, provides an avenue for leadership, and promotes self-betterment.

On April 15, 2007, Sigma Beta Rho Fraternity was inducted into the **North-American Interfraternity Conference (NIC)** as its 69th member. Sigma Beta Rho has since maintained active status with the NIC.

Sigma Beta Rho also is a charter member, or founding member, of the **National APIA Panhellenic Association (NAPA)**. Furthermore, Sigma Beta Rho member, the late Akash Kuruvilla, co-authored the original constitution for NAPA.
