FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is new member education and how long will it take?

More than anything else, new member education is a learning period during which a potential new member becomes well-versed in the values and ideals of Sigma Beta Rho, along with its history and traditions. Most importantly, though, this period represents a chance for all potential new members to get acquainted with the brothers of the fraternity, and vice versa. Each class of potential new members is assigned a New Member educator who will lead them through this process. This New Member Educator will interact very closely with his potential new members throughout the process. He acts as the ultimate judge of their successful completion of the new member education program. There is no predetermined time period for the successful completion of this program.

If I work or am taking a heavy class schedule, will I have time for new member education?

One of the major virtues of any successful individual, and one we value highly, is the ability to manage his or her time efficiently. As such, time management is one of the key elements we stress during the new member education period. We understand that many men have obligations outside of our fraternity. We honor those obligations and will make every attempt to accommodate your schedule. However, it is for you to decide if you want to manage your time efficiently. You will find that we can be very flexible with respect to your class and work schedules.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will my grades drop if I try to become a new member?

Grades drop when your work is either incomplete or late and not completed with quality. While new member education may take a considerable amount of time away from your normal lifestyle, along the lines of the above answer, effective time management is a must. As is required by most colleges and universities, Sigma Beta Rho's new member education program mandates study hours for every potential new member, fostering good study habits. Furthermore, New Member Educators and Academic Chairs monitor grades through weekly progress reports.

Will I be hazed?

No! Sigma Beta Rho is a strictly non-hazing organization. Our constitution strictly forbids brothers from hazing potential new members. Any brother who is discovered to have violated this policy will find himself expelled from Sigma Beta Rho.

How much will it cost to become a new member?

Sigma Beta Rho does not charge a fee to participate in the new member education program. However, the process may require you to purchase certain materials. These materials are affordable by the average college student.
